

Do You Need a Spanish Interpreter For Court?

Do you have a case in the Skagit County Superior Court? Do you speak Spanish and have trouble speaking or understanding English?

You can ask for a Spanish interpreter to interpret in the courtroom for you, without cost to you.

IF YOU NEED AN INTERPRETER, THIS IS WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- Fill out the form below and take it to the Court Administrator's office, 2nd floor - Skagit County Courthouse. **Do this 2-5 days BEFORE your hearing. If you have more than one hearing, use additional forms.**
- If your hearing is cancelled or the date changes, you must **immediately tell the Court Administrator's office** by calling (360) 336-9320 or in-person at the Court Administrator's office (2nd floor courthouse). This will let the court cancel the interpreter.
